A criminal defence lawyer, called to Nigerian bar in 1992, expert in criminal law, human rights, mediator, justice reform, he is the Chairman of the Nigeria Coalition for the International Criminal Court (NCICC), National Coordinator of Legal Defence & Assistance Project (LEDAP) and partner at law firm of Obiagwu & Obiagwu. He is the Chair of Human Rights Agenda Network (HRAN), comprising NGOs working on human rights in Nigeria, and headed the National Working Group on the Reform of Criminal Justice Administration in Nigeria 2007-2010. He has personally litigated over 125 death penalty cases at trials and appeals, including legal challenge of mandatory death penalty and arbitrary execution warrants in Nigeria.
